BUYING A HOME?

If you are a first-time homebuyer or a homebuyer who has not owned a home for at least three years, you may be eligible for up to \$6,000 to help pay the down payment and/or closing costs on a home in Renville County.

To be eligible, you must live in the home after you purchase it. You must buy the home with a mortgage, not a contract for deed, and the home must be a permanent structure.

While funds last, up to \$6,000 is available from the Renville County HRA/EDA to match funds you put in from your savings or another source to pay the down payment and closing costs on your home.

Funds from the Homeownership Down Payment Program are a 0% loan that does not have to be repaid until you move out of the home, sell the home, or pay off the first mortgage.

Approval of a homeownership down payment or rehab loan is subject to review, as well as the condition of the home.





FIXING UP YOUR HOME?

If you are a homeowner/occupant in Renville County, you may be eligible for up to \$6,000 to match funds you use to do permanent repairs to your home.

For example, if you put new siding on your house at a cost of \$8,000, the Homeownership Rehab Program would lend you \$4,000. The loans are 0% interest and are repayable over five years, with payments beginning the month after your loan closes. For very low income households, repayment of the loan is deferred until other home loans have been repaid.

Eligible repairs include roofs, siding, painting, insulation, mechanical systems, windows and doors, concrete or masonry work, additions, accessibility features, demolition to allow new construction, or other permanent improvements.

Borrowers must own their home outright or be purchasing it on a mortgage. The home must be a permanent structure in Renville County. Borrowers must be current on their real estate taxes and carry homeowner's insurance.

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

In order to qualify for the Renville County
Homeownership Down Payment and Rehab
Program, your household must meet certain
income guidelines. Maximum incomes for the
program are based on household size and are
shown below:
