

Renville County participates in the Performance Measurement Program administered by the State Auditor's Office. The program provides a reimbursement of \$0.14 per capita for counties and cities that collect and report on a set of standard measures, and exempts participating entities from levy limits that might be in effect. The Renville County data collected and reported in 2019 is listed below:

1. Performance Measure: Part I and Part II Crime Rates

Performance Goal: Decrease Part I and Part II Crime Rates

Outcome: In 2018, the Renville County Sheriff's Office received reports and investigated 83 Part I crimes and 596 Part II crimes.

2. Performance Measure: Recycling Rate

Performance Goal: Increase Recycling Rate for Renville County to 50%.

Outcome: The recycling rate for Renville County is approximately 52.92%.

3. <u>Performance Measure: Average County Pavement</u> <u>Condition Rating</u>

Performance Goal: To improve the average county pavement condition rating over five years.

Outcome: Renville County Average Pavement Condition Rating is 2.7/4.

4. <u>Performance Measure: Average County Bridge</u> <u>Sufficiency Rating</u>

Performance Goal: To improve the average county bridge sufficiency rating over five years.

Outcome: Renville County Average County Bridge Sufficiency Rating 86.4/100.

5. <u>Performance Measure: Behavioral Risk Factor</u> <u>Surveillance System Rating</u>

Performance Goal: To attain high quality and longer lives free from preventable disease, disability, injury and premature death in Renville County and to promote quality of life, healthy development and healthy behaviors across all life stages.

Outcome: Percentage of sexually active students who reported always using a condom 64.75% (2016 MN Student Health Survey Result). Percentage of students reporting, in the past 7 days, how many times they ate vegetables: 4 or more per day, 6.38%; 4-6 times in the last 7 days, 24.13%; none in 7 days 9.75%. Renville County premature death rate (under 75 years, adjusted rate 2013 – 2017): Cancer, 70.1; Heart Disease, 62.3; Unintentional Injury, 40.4

6. Performance Measure: Workforce Participation Rate

Performance Goal: To increase the workforce participation rate over five years.

Outcome: Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) workforce participation rate was 50%.

7. <u>Performance Measure: Percentage of Children</u> where there is a Recurrence of Maltreatment within 12 <u>Months Following Intervention</u>

Performance Goal: Maintain a 0% recurrence rate.

Outcome: In 2018, 0% of children had a recurrence of maltreatment within 12 months following intervention.

8. <u>Performance Measure: Level of Assessment Ratio</u>

Performance Goal: Maintain an acceptable assessment ratio between 90% and 105%.

Outcome: Renville County has an overall assessment ratio for 2018 of 97.81%.

9. <u>Performance Measure: Accuracy of Post-Election</u> <u>Audit</u>

Performance Goal: To maintain 100% accuracy of ballots counted for each election.

Outcome: 100% accuracy.

10. Performance Measure: Percentage of Veterans Surveyed Who Said Their Questions Were Answered When Seeking Benefit Information from their County Veteran's Service Officer

Performance Goal: Maintain 100% positive response.

Outcome: 99.19%

11. Performance Measure: Citizens Survey of Renville County Parks

Performance Goal: Provide outdoor recreation opportunities, while protecting the natural resources of Renville County, for the use, enjoyment, and education of present and future generations.

Outcome: 97.59% of respondents replied that their overall opinion of the Renville County Park System was fair to excellent.
