

Situational Update: How to Care for Your Homemade Facemask

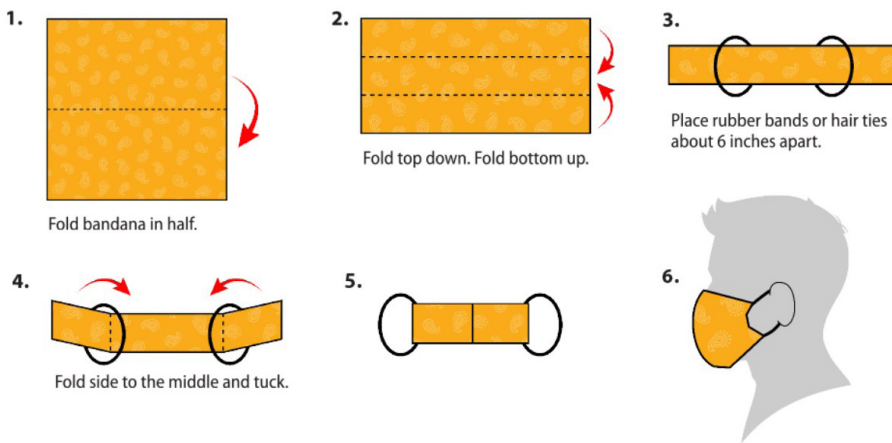
- Wash your hands before putting the mask on and after you take the mask off.
- While wearing the mask, you should still be coughing or sneezing into your elbow.
- The mask is not a substitute for you to go out if feeling ill. Stay home.
- The mask does not protect you from catching an illness from others. It protects others from you.
- To reuse your mask during the day, fold it so the outside surfaces are folded together. Store in clean paper bag.
- At the end of each day, wash your mask in hot water using regular detergent. Dry on hot heat.



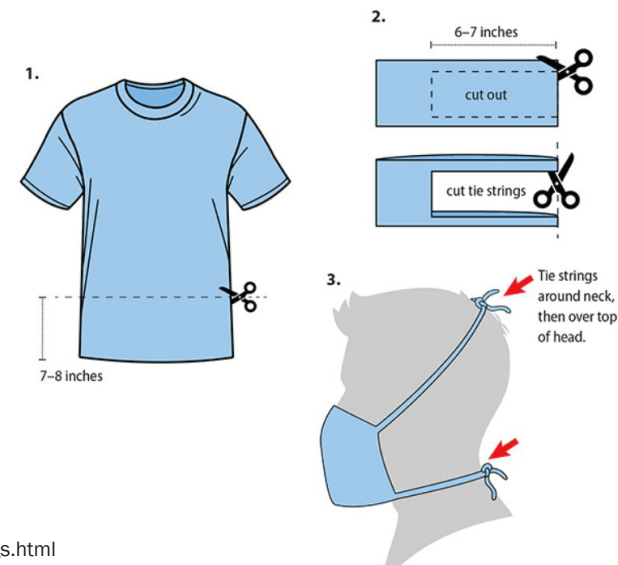
NEED A PERSONAL FACEMASK? HERE ARE TWO SIMPLE MASKS YOU CAN MAKE AT HOME:

Bandana Face Covering

Use a bandana or 20"x 20" square cotton cloth and rubber bands or hair ties
