# Preparedness Activities

- Revised & updated Emergency Operations Plan (EOP)
- Moved Emergency Operations Center (EOC) location
- Outreach and education
- Conducted 17 training/workshops (3 required)
  - 2 schools
  - 6 healthcare facilities
  - 9 local governments

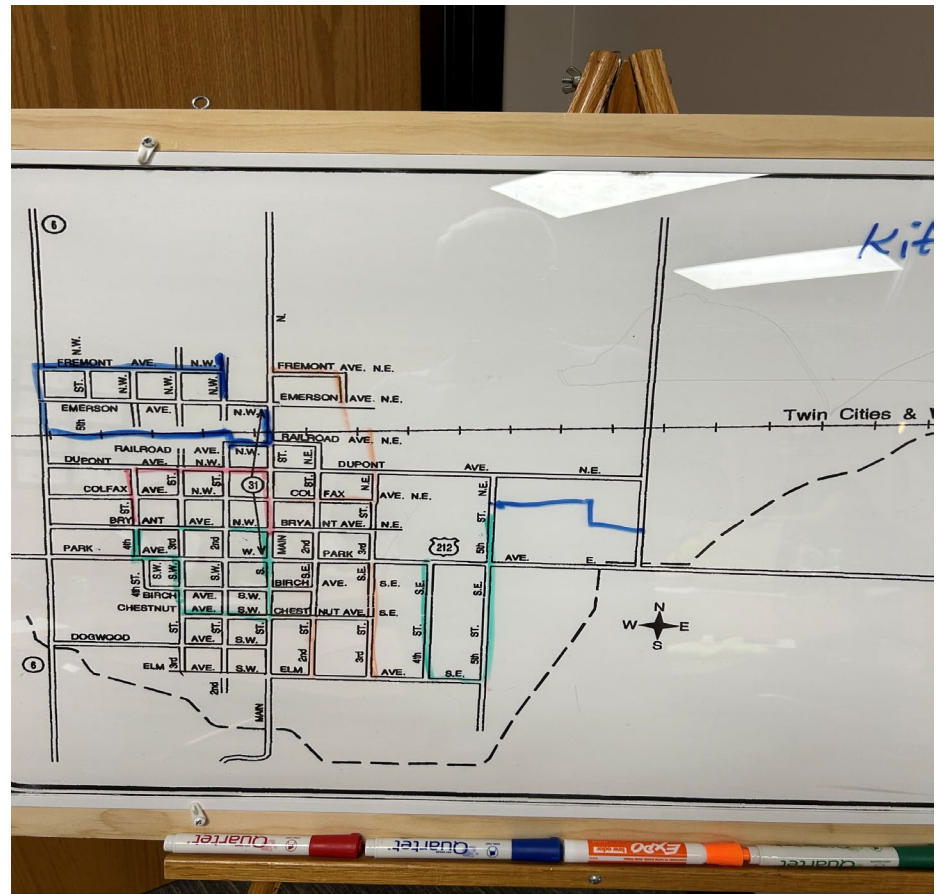

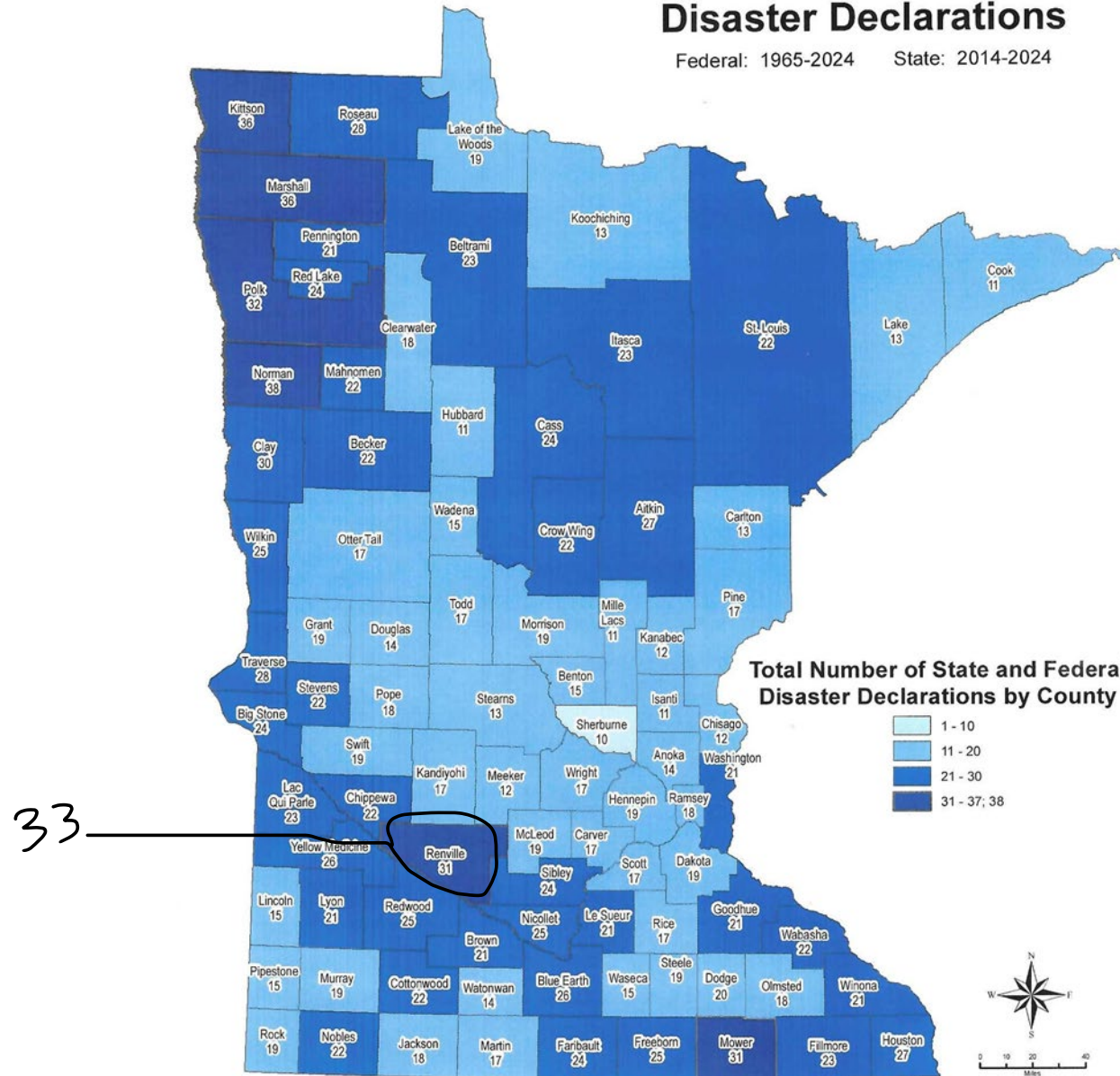

# Minnesota State and Federal Disaster Declarations

Federal: 1965-2024    State: 2014-2024



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## 2026 Disaster Recovery Criteria - Renville County

- **Federal (FEMA) Robert T. Stafford Act**
  - \$4,100 qualifying damage per applicant
  - \$71,600 qualifying damage for Renville County
- **AND**
- \$11.1 million statewide
  - 75% federal 25% state 0% local
- **State (DACA) Statute 12B, appropriated as needed**
  - \$4,100 qualifying damage per applicant
  - \$35,800 qualifying damage to uninsured government property
  - No state threshold
    - 75% state 25% local



# Process

- Incident report (within 24 hours)
- Compile information
- Report to State HSEM (within 48 hours)
- Seek County Board approval for a state of emergency (within 72 hours)
- Coordinate with HSEM for PDA & Applicant Briefing (within 30 days)
- Initiate formal request to Governor for recovery funds
